1 large backpack

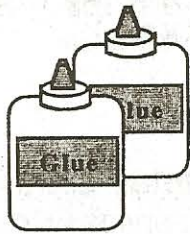
(zipper-no drawstrings, please put name on with permanent marker)

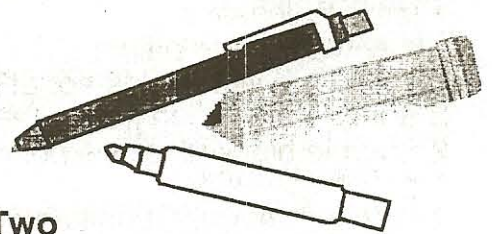
Grade One

- 1 - two inch 3-ring binder,
full name on spine
No dark colors please-they are hard to label with name
 - 1 - **CLOTH** zipper pouch to go in binder
 - 24 - #2 pencils - **pre-sharpened**
 - 1 - pointed end scissors (Fiskar brand)
 - 1 - 6 or 8 oz bottle Elmer's white glue
 - 2 - boxes of crayons - 24 colors
 - 1 - pkg. felt markers (10 pack)
 - 1 - pack of 15 eraser tops
 - 2 - large box of facial tissues
 - 20 - glue sticks (not liquid, white glue only)
 - 2 - large box wet wipes
 - 1 - roll of paper towels
 - 1 - sturdy homework folder with bottom pockets - no rings - no side pockets
 - 1 - tray watercolor paints

Grade Four

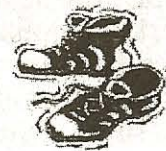
- 1 - 1 1/2 or 2 inch 3-ring binder

 - 1 box baby wipes
 - 5 - 70 page wide-ruled spiral notebooks
 - 2 Magic Rub erasers
 - 1 black fine point Sharpie pen
 - 5 black felt-tip markers, non permanent
 - 1 protractor
 - 1 supply box (small)

- 1 - 2 inch 3-ring binder
 - 12 - #2 pencils
 - 1 blue or black ball point pen
 - 1 set colored pencils
 - 1 set fine tip felt markers/assorted colors

 - 1 large pointed end scissors
 - 1 box facial tissue
 - 1 box baby wipes
 - 4 - 70 page wide-ruled spiral notebooks
 - 1 pkg. wide-ruled notebook paper
 - 1 Magic Rub eraser
 - 1 Sharpie pen, Ultra fine tip
 - 1 zippered pouch for binder
